Numbers will be painted on the Competitors' Cars by the Organisers.

Numbers must not be displayed after the conclusion of the Tests.

Competitors will proceed through Tests 1, 2, 3, consecutively and return to the Paddock for the short interval. Tests 4 and 5 will

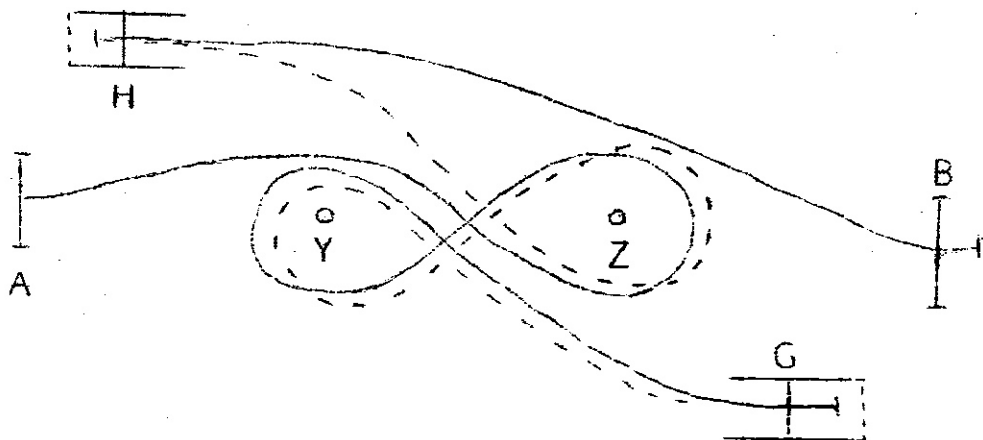
y. then be attempted, afterwards returning to the Paddock. If there is sufficient time Tests 4 and 5 will be attempted a second time.

TEST ONE



Start Line A. Proceed through figure 8, passing on left of Pylon Y, into Garage G. Reverse through figure 8, passing top of Pylon Z, into Garage H. Forward, to finish wheels astride Line B.

This entails Competitors completing a full figure 8 in both forward and reverse.

TIMING: From Start Line A to finish wheels astride Line B.

SURFACE: Loose gravel.

TEST TWO



Start Line A. Proceed through Pylons, passing right of W, left of X and so on, to wheels astride Line B. Reverse through Pylons to right of Z, left of Y and so on, to wheels astride Line A. Forward through Pylons again, right of W, etc., to finish wheels astride Line B.

TIMING: As in Test 1.

SURFACE: Hard sets and macadam.

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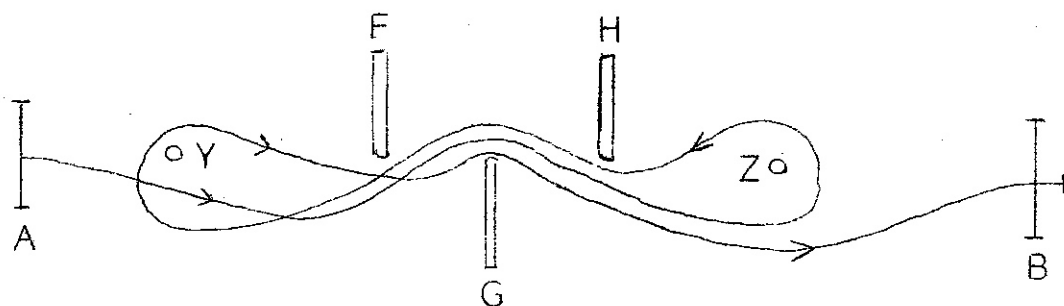

TEST THREE

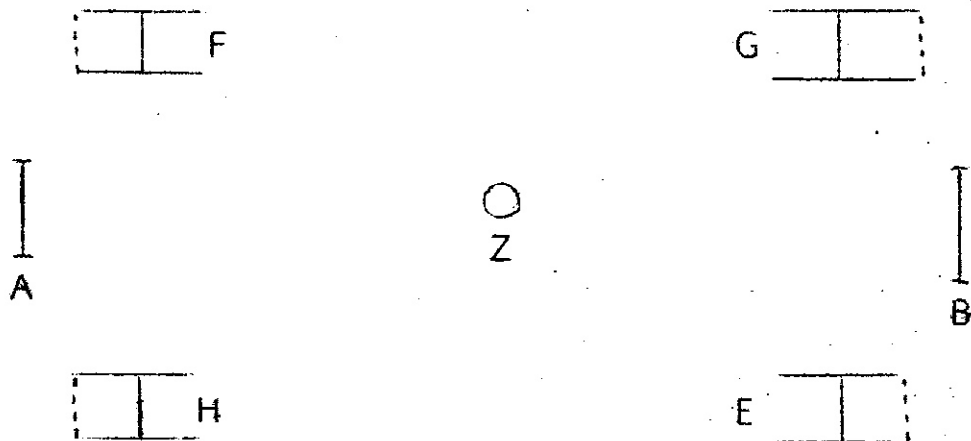


Start Line A. Proceed to the right of Y and through Chicane, round Z left handed, through Chicane, round Y right handed, to finish wheels astride Line B.

TIMING: As in Tests 1 and 2.

SURFACE: Hard sets and macadam.

TEST FOUR



Start Line A. Competitors must enter all four Garages E, F, G, H, in correct order. Garages E, F, G, to be entered in reverse direction, and Garage H in forward direction, to finish wheels astride Line B.

TIMING: As in Tests 1, 2 and 3.

SURFACE: Loose gravel.

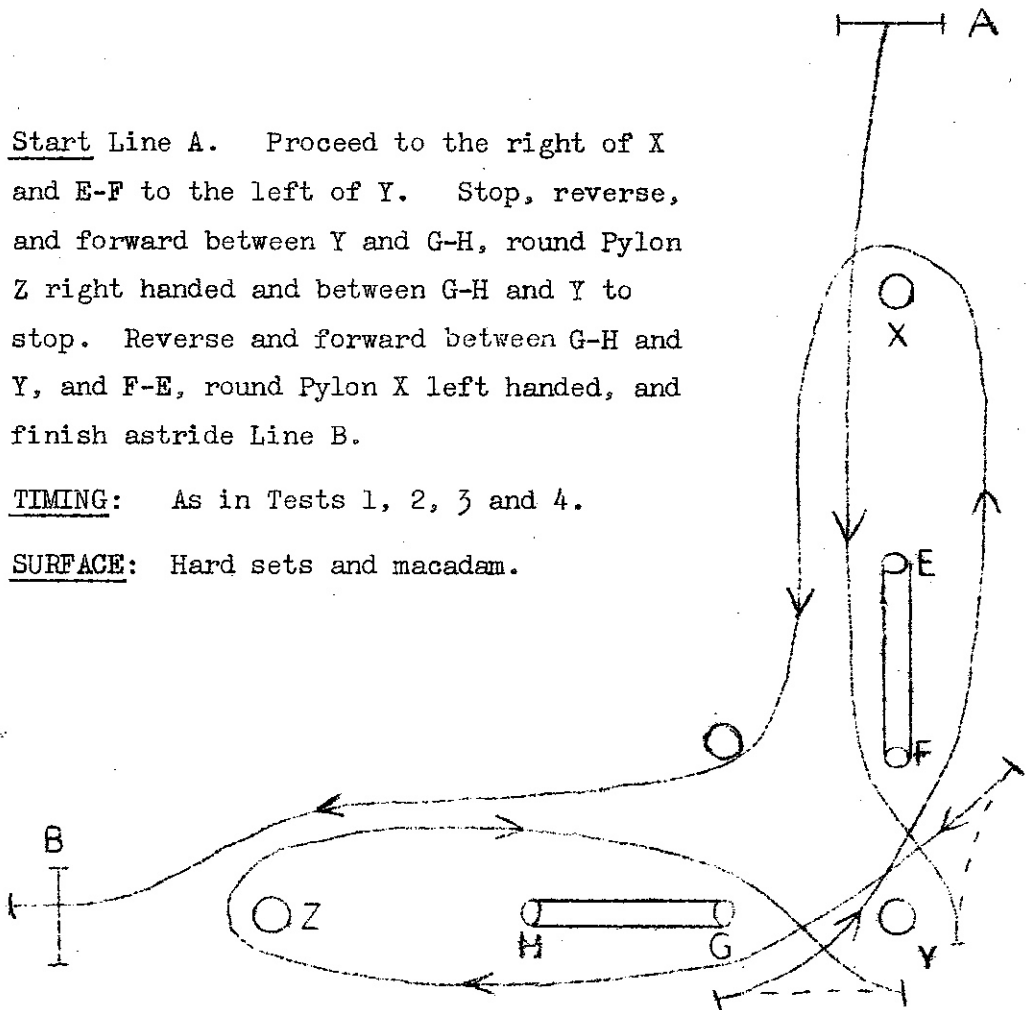
TEST FIVE

MONTE - ROCHDALE

Start Line A. Proceed to the right of X and E-F to the left of Y. Stop, reverse, and forward between Y and G-H, round Pylon Z right handed and between G-H and Y to stop. Reverse and forward between G-H and Y, and F-E, round Pylon X left handed, and finish astride Line B.

TIMING: As in Tests 1, 2, 3 and 4.

SURFACE: Hard sets and macadam.
