Proceedings

The Chair welcomed everyone to the AGM.

The meeting read and approved the Minutes of the 71st AGM, held on 30th May 2022.

The meeting read and approved the Annual Report Of The Committee For 2023.

The meeting read and adopted the Balance Sheet and Approved Accounts.

These showed a profit of £108 for the year which arose from mainly from the Touring Assemblies and Christmas Auction. From the floor, H Walker commented on the best value of any of the clubs he knows provided by Knowldale.

The meeting re-elected the accountants for the following year with a vote of thanks.

Five members of the Committee –S Broadbent, D Lord, D Pickup, P Stringer and S Warrington were willing to continue as committee members and were re-elected unopposed. T Mills had not attended any committee meeting for many months and thus was required, in his absence, to stand down. P Dean, currently co-opted was proposed to fill the resulting vacancy on the Committee and the Meeting voted in his favour.

A proposal that the annual rate of subscription should remain at £15 was accepted with little discussion.

Any Other Business:

Alan Kitson (assisted by Steve Warrington) was thanked for providing Pies & Peas during the meeting.

Alan Kitson announced the revival of the Knowldale Annual Dinner/Disco to be held at the Bella Vista on January 25th 2025.

Keith Oldham told of his Drive It Day run which raised £400 for the Yorkshire Air Ambulance. On 25th August he is organising a run in aid of Springhill Hospice. This is the same day as the KCC Barbecue, so it was suggested he has the finish at the Cricket Club so participants have the option of joining us.

Grace Pedley thanked the club for its support since she has been accepted into the Motorsport UK Academy programme. The club is assisting with the cost of attending the five training days involved. In return Grace is providing reports which are posted on the Knowldale Facebook Group page.

P Waud asked a question about the membership fees and about the profitability of events. Since beginning to promote Touring Assemblies the club has adopted a policy of providing events to all-comers and services to members at a cost which at least covers expenditure. The club has reserves to cover predictable shortfalls and has been fortunate in running profitable events.

D Clegg asked if the Motorsport UK StreetCar programme which we joined in 2023 had benefitted the club. We have had one or two enquiries forwarded from MsUK but don't believe anything further has happened.

D Pedley asked if we could approach ANCC with a view to rejoining since club members competing on their events can't register as Knowldale if the ANWCC or SD34 aren't invited.

The meeting closed at 9:42pm.
