– *MotorSport UK StreetCar* -

Saturday 4th October 2025
Additional Supplementary Regulations

1. **Announcement**

Knowldale Car Club Ltd will organise a Touring Assembly to be known as the The Knowldale Autumn Tour - *MotorSport UK StreetCar* - on Saturday 4th October 2025. The event will start from Fairways Garden Centre, Macclesfield (SK11 0HE) and finish at Milnrow Cricket Club (OL16 4HF.)

2. **Organisation of the Event**

- a. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK together with these Supplementary Regulations and any additional Instructions which may be issued by the organisers during the event. All entrants undertake to comply with these Regulations by completing the official entry form.
- b. A Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption has been applied for.

3. **Eligibility**

- a. The event is open to all-comers, especially those with Classic, Collectors and Historic vehicles and members of one-make car clubs.
- b. All drivers must be over 17 years of age and hold a valid full driving licence for the vehicle being driven. (A Motorsport UK Competition Licence is NOT required.)
- c. Only drivers nominated on the entry form are permitted to drive.
- d. Passengers may be carried up to the maximum number for which proper seating is provided in the vehicle entered.
- e. Any road legal car will be eligible to take part but priority will be given to entrants with Classic, Collectors and Historic vehicles and members of one-make car clubs.
- f. Entrants will be provided with a Rally Plate which must be displayed in a prominent forward facing position at the front of the car. No other number may be displayed other than the vehicle registration number and manufacturer's badging.

4. **Entries**

- b. The Entry List opens on the publication of these Regulations and entries must be received by the closing date Tuesday 30th September 2025.
- c. The Entry fee will be £55 per vehicle for a crew of two (driver and navigator.) Additional passengers are permitted at a cost of £16 each up to the maximum number for which proper seating is provided within the vehicle.
- d. Entries must be made via Rallies.info at rallies.info/webentry/2025/autumntour/webentry.php

- e. All entry fees are payable in advance but will be refunded if the event is cancelled or the entry is withdrawn in writing prior to the closing date of Tuesday 30th September 2025. Refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date will be at the sole discretion of Knowldale Car Club Ltd. All refunds made will take into account any expenses already incurred.
- f. The Entry fee includes:-
- Detailed final instructions
 - A fully detailed Road Book.
 - A Monte Carlo Style Rally Plate
 - A bacon butty and brew for the driver, navigator and any paid additional passengers at the start
 - A potato pie meal at the finish for driver, navigator and any paid additional passengers
- g. The maximum number of entries for the event is 50 and the minimum is 20. Should the maximum number be exceeded the entry list will be determined by the date the entry was received. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event should the minimum number not be achieved by the closing date for entries.
- h. Knowldale Car Club Ltd, as the event organiser, reserves the right to refuse an entry and is not bound to give reasons for so doing.

5. Programme

Please note other than the time of the pre-event formalities at the start venue, other timings are simply a guide to assist you in planning your day.

09:00	Arrival and Documentation
10:00	First car leaves the Start
14:30	First car due at the Finish.

6. Insurance

- a. Drivers must have valid insurance in accordance with the Road Traffic Acts and relevant laws applicable in the United Kingdom and will be required to sign a declaration that they are covered by such insurance.
- b. All participants in the event must sign an indemnity required under the terms of the policy held by the organisers relevant to the event.

7. Documentation and Vehicle check

- a. During the week prior to the event entrants will receive by eMail the Final Instructions and other relevant documents.
- b. Vehicle examination (visual inspection) may be carried out at the start and may also be undertaken at a subsequent location on the event.
- c. Any vehicle observed to be in an un-roadworthy condition at the vehicle check or at any time during the event will not be permitted to start/continue.
- d. All entrants (driver, navigator and any passengers) are required to “Sign On.” At the Start venue, documentation detailing a suggested route will be issued. As this is not a competition entrants may choose to follow the suggested route or to determine their own.

8. The Start

- a. The event will start from Fairways Garden Centre, Macclesfield (SK11 0HE)
- b. The starting order will be at the organiser’s discretion.
- c. Cars will leave the start at intervals of one minute.
- d. Individual start times will be included with the final instructions.
- e. Any car starting late will be deemed to have started at their allocated start time.

9. Route

- a. The suggested Route will be approximately 120 miles and will vary from A to C class roads and may include sections over private land.
- b. A full Tulip Road Book will be provided. **The mileages in the Road Book have been set using the KCC Tripmeter app.** (Several apps are available for both Android and iOS devices.)
- c. OS Map references defining the route will be provided. **The OS map numbers required for those who would like to plot the route are 109, 110.**
- d. An overall time allowance will be given for the route.
- e. Check Points will be set up at various locations. Some will be manned, at others a Knowl Dale Code Board will display a code.
- f. All manned Check Points will remain open to allow all entrants following the suggested route sufficient time to visit them whilst travelling well below all legal speed limits.
- g. The Start and Finish will be manned Check Points.
- h. At each manned Check Point the marshal present will record the arrival of each car.
- i. At unmanned points the code displayed must be entered by the entrant in the appropriate place on the Code Board Check Sheet which will be provided at the Start.

10. The Finish

- a. The finish will be at Milnrow Cricket Club where a meal will be served and a range of beverages will be available to purchase.
- b. To be recorded as a Finisher, entrants must visit the start and finish and hand in a completed Check Point Record Card together with a signed Damage Declaration Sheet.

11. Jurisdiction and Penalties

- a. The Clerk of Course for the event :-
 - i. Has absolute discretion in the interpretation and application of the Regulations plus the implementation of any penalty for any breach of the Regulations and or Appendices.
 - ii. May implement decisions on any matter not provided for in these Regulations.
- b. The penalty for any:-
 - i. Breach of these Regulations
 - ii. Breach of traffic law
 - iii. Prejudicial behaviour or conduct
 - iv. Matters not specified in these regulationsmay be a reprimand or exclusion or both.
- c. Notwithstanding the rights of the entrant, protests will be considered by the organisers to be not within the spirit of the event and may be viewed with disfavour.
